KEY FEATURES

- Bred in New Zealand by prominent plantsman, Jack Hobbs
- Smothered in masses of shell-pink flowers from early to late summer, attracting bees and other pollinating insects
- Forms a dense, low spreading shrub with cascading branches of attractive bronzed young foliage, which matures to a pleasant grey-green
- Excellent for mass planting on difficult banks, adding texture and colour to garden borders, and as a large container specimen
- Pest and disease resistant, coastal, wind and frost hardy, drought and heat tolerant
